WINERY OVERVIEW

Alessandro Furlan made wine at his family's vineyard in Friuli, "Franco Furlan," for years before deciding to start his own label with longtime friend and owner of Regal Wine Imports, Charlie Trivinia.

Sourced from some of the best vineyards in the Prosecco DOC, Alessandro Furlan carefully selects and blends the wines to maintain a consistent style with fresh flavors. The wine is then carefully blended and bottled at a leading Veneto producer's facility.

The wines are named in honor of women in the Furlan Family. Ca' Furlan Prosecco, Cuvee Beatrice is named in honor of Alessandro's Mother, Beatrice.

First imported in 2008 with only a small number of cases, Ca' Furlan has successfully flourished and grown to be a very well-respected brand in the United States. In 2016, Ca' Furlan Prosecco was featured by Alison Napjus of the Wine Spectator as one of the top sparkling wine values for the year. Today, Ca' Furlan also offers 187ml 3-packs of Cuvee Beatrice, Sparkling Moscato Cuvee Adriana, and Prosecco Rose.

VINEYARD

Veneto region

VINIFICATION

Gentle pressing of clusters with membrane presses followed by immediate skin separation and static cold-settling for clear must. Fermentation in temperature controlled tanks using cultured yeasts. The Charmat process is known as Metodo Chamat-Martinotti (or Metodo Italiano) in Italy, where it was invented and is most used. The wine undergoes "secondary" fermentation in stainless steel tanks or steel vessels covered with vitreous enamel rather than individual bottles, and is bottled under pressure in a continuous process.

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
