VINEYARD NOTES

From South Africa's only Grenache gris vineyard. Grown in the granite soils on the Voor-Paardeberg. Average yield of 8-10 tons/ha.

WINEMAKING NOTES

Grapes were harvested in the last week of February. Fermentation was in open top fermenters, daily pump overs and punch downs for 12 days. Grapes pressed directly into old barrels, 225, 300 and 400 liter barrels. Left on the gross lees until bottling in Nov.

TASTING NOTES

Raw almonds and marzipan leads the first impressions of this wine, backed up by floral aromas. The fresh core of the palate is beautifully balanced by the tannin and structure. A savory, almost saline finish rounds of profile. A brilliant match to all things fresh from the garden to the ocean.
